Consumers' Research v. FCC

• 5th Circuit Court of Appeals rules USF, as currently administered, is unconstitutional

MCP No. 185 Open Internet Rule (FCC 24-52)

- 6th Circuit review of FCC's Open Internet Rule
- Panel of judges held hearing on October 31

Minnesota Telecom Alliance, et al v. FCC

• 8th Circuit review of FCC's Digital Discrimination Rules

Loper Bright Enterprises v. Riamondo

• Supreme Court overturned Chevron deference

LOOKING AHEAD - TAXING BROADBAND GRANTS

Bonus Depreciation - Will it get Extended?

- Current law: 60% bonus depreciation for property placed in service in 2024
 - o Phase out: 2025-40%, 2026-20%
- Bipartisan tax bill passed House Extends 100% bonus depreciation through 2026

Broadband Grant Tax Treatment Act

• S. 341/H.R. 889 - Bipartisan legislation to exempt broadband grants from taxation

2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act – Many provisions expiring next year
